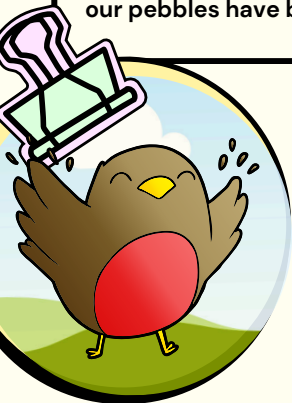
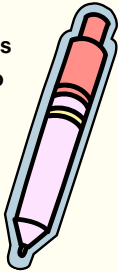


Robins Curriculum Map

Term 3

Writing

This term we will be taking a journey through the ages, using the book 'The Pebble In My Pocket: The History of Our Earth by Meredith Hooper.' Each child will receive their own pebble to spark curiosity and bring our SPaG focus to life (Prepositions, adjectives and verbs). Our lessons will build up to us writing our very own kenning poems about our pebbles. We will also wow you with a descriptive piece of writing about the journeys our pebbles have been on.



Reading

This term we will be reading from an array of genres. Our reading lessons will focus on;

Maths

Our focus this term is place value and number.

Science

Our Science topic this term is : Rocks and fossils.

We will be identifying, grouping and testing different types of rock. We will also be carrying out a rock survey in and around our school, we are curious to know which types of rock are in and around our school premises.

Toward the end of term our focus will shift to fossils, inspired by Mary Anning, one of the first paleontologists and fossil hunters.
