We will be dealing with some sensitive issues from the past and expect children to approach these with respect and understanding.

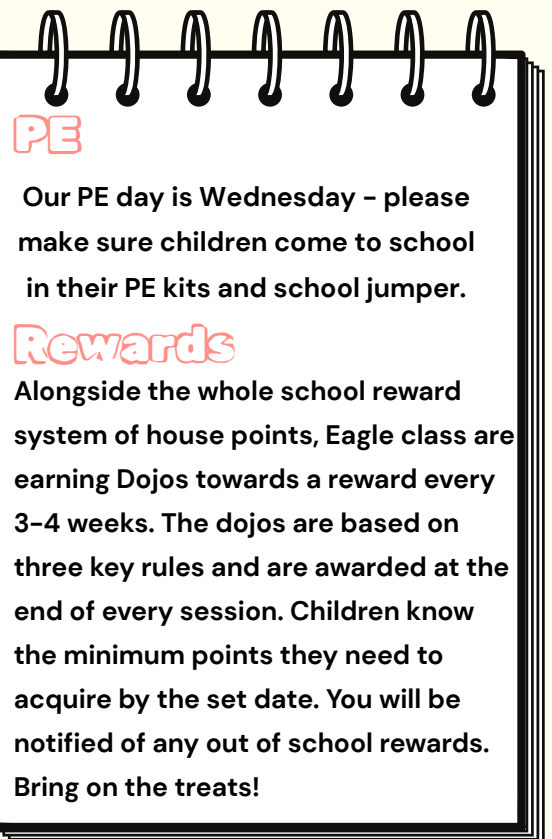
