PE

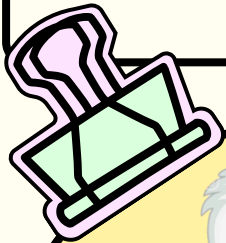

If this is the case for your child, please ensure they bring grip socks (flip out, ninja warrior) with them to wear on their PE day.

Reading

Reading is an integral part of you child's learning. The aim is that all children read at home at least **3 times a week**. Remember to write in the purple book when your child has read.
