Term 3

Writing

Following our new text 'how to find gold' The children will be writing an acrostic poem focusing on adjectives. The children will also be writing an explanation piece while we begin to look at exclamations and question marks. Our final piece will be a book report with the focus being proper nouns and verbs ending with -ed.

Reading

As well as our reading book for English, year 1 will be taking home two books each week; one of them being a book of choice from our school library, and the other a 'ditty' book to support our phonics. Throughout the week, the children participate in 'Whole Class Reading', where they study and discuss a text over the course of a few days.
