What to expect in term 4!

Our topic in Term 4 is 'People and Vehicles Who Help Us'

We will be looking at the different organisations who help us including the RNLI, Ambulance service, Doctors, Police, Fire Service, Builders, Farmers and Vets. We will also talk about other people who help us within our community.

We will be looking at the role these people play in our lives and what their jobs involve as well as the vehicles and equipment they use.

We will also learn how to make 999 calls in an emergency and learn to understand what an emergency is.

Trips and Visitors

We will be enriching our topic this term with visitors and trips. We will start the term with a visit from Dr Miles, who will talk to the children about her job, We will also look at the equipment used by firefighters and Police. We will be taking a trip to the Dungeness Lifeboat Station to see the RNLI and we will also take a trip to Mrs Lockwood's working farm to learn about the role of a farmer and to see sheep lambing and calves at the farm. We have a very busy term ahead.
