

# Penguins Curriculum Map

## Writing

Our English work will be based around our topic of People and Vehicles Who help us, we will write about the different jobs and what they do. We will label the different parts of the vehicles and uniform. We will use some fiction books to focus the different areas of reading and writing and will link these to jobs. We will look at a book called Astro Girl and also what the Ladybird heard.

## Phonics

In Phonics the children are now learning digraphs which are sounds made up of two or three letters. They are practising segmenting and blending these sounds in new words and using these skills in their reading and writing. We will also learn to read high frequency words that do not follow spelling patterns.

## Term 4

## Maths

Much of our Maths teaching will continue to be through play based activities. We will also continue to use Number Blocks as starting points to our teaching. This term we will extend our numbers to 20 and continue counting beyond. We are starting to apply addition and subtraction concepts to our learning as well as combining sets of numbers

## PSHE

This term's PSHE focus is titled 'Healthy Me'. Children will be learning about maintaining a healthy lifestyle. Their lessons will focus on exercising, food choices. In year R we will be talking about healthy diets and exercise. Should you have any questions about the PSHE curriculum, please come and speak to us.

## Learning Journey

This term the children will have the opportunity to build models of emergency vehicles, paint pictures of them and recreate scenarios with cars and small world characters. There will be lots of role play and dressing up as people who help us
