
Term 5

Writing

Following our new text 'The Lonely Beast' the children will be writing a wanted poster and letter, to include suffixes such as er and est, as well as including the correct plural form. It is important that the children begin to read over their own work in order to identify, correct and develop their ideas.

Reading

As well as our reading book for English, year 1 will be taking home two books each week; one of them being a book of choice from our school library, and the other a 'ditty' book to support our phonics. Throughout the week, the children participate in 'Whole Class Reading', where they study and discuss a text over the course of a few days. The text choices will be linked to the 'Land and Water' theme for the term.

Maths

This term, year 1 will learn place value within 100. They shall learn about multiplication and division, counting in 2s, 5s and 10s as well as doubling and halving, through grouping and sharing. They will also be learning about half and quarter as fractions.

We shall be looking at the parts of plants and investigating the differences between wild gardens and those in our local environment. We shall also evaluate deciduous and evergreen trees and again review trees in the local area.
