

# Penguins Curriculum Map

## Writing

Our English work will be based around our topic of Life on Land and Water. As well as the story books, we will also use some non fiction books to focus on lifecycles, minibeasts and different land and sea creatures. We will retell the stories as well as start to make minibeast fact files.



## Phonics

In Phonics the children are continuing their read Write Inc in groups, they have been assessed ready for their new group. They are learning new sounds and practising learnt sounds. They are practising segmenting and blending sounds in new words and using these skills in their reading and writing. We will also learn to read high frequency words that do not follow spelling patterns.

## Maths

This term we will continue to practise and become fluent in our counting and using numbers to 20 and continue counting beyond. We still consolidating our skills of addition and subtraction through concepts such as combining sets of numbers. We will also have a look at weighing and measuring using non standard units. This will be linked to our topic.



## PSHE

This term's PSHE focus is around building healthy relationships. The children across the year groups will learn how to make and sustain friendships as well as recognising how friendships can change. Over the course of the term, the children will recap about keeping safe online; then build an awareness of taking care of their own mental health.
