Writing

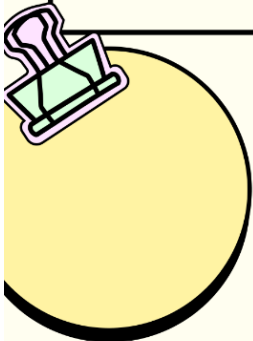
