Term 6

Writing

Writing this term will focus in the text 'The Stolen Spear' by Saviour Pirotta. We will begin with a dairy entry writing in role as one of the characters and will focus on the correct use of tenses as well as continue to extend the range of conjunctions and fronted adverbials in our written work.

Handwriting and spelling will continue to be a focus, please ensure your child is logging onto Spelling Shed weekly to learn the set spellings.



Reading

This term Ravens will develop their comprehension skills in focussed sessions learning how to unpick key elements of questions using a past assessment paper to help them.

We will continue whole class reading looking at a range of fiction and non fiction texts, developing understanding of a range of question types, particularly sequencing. Term 6 will also see the children working towards their final points target in AR for year 4. We were proud of the children who reached their AR target in term 4 and now would like more of them to reach this in term 6!



Maths

This term we will cover the following areas as part of our maths curriculum.

Time

- Recall time related facts such as the number of seconds in a minute, minutes in an hour.
- Convert between analogue and digital times.
- Convert between the 12 and 24-hour time formats

Shape, position and direction will follow.



Science

Focus: The Digestive System

Teeth- We will examine teeth from a variety of different animals as well as human teeth, learning their functions. The we will look at the parts of the body involved with the human digestive system and their functions.

Focus: Food Chains

We will read food chains and interpret the information they provide. we will then draw our own food chains.



Learning Journey

History
In History this term we will concentrate on answering the following questions:

- What can we find out about the people of Glastonbury Lake village?
- How did Iron age hillforts help tribes gain victory during battles?
- Why was Boudicca significant and how was she defeated by the Romans?

DT
In DT we will be focussing on textiles. and will make a small purse/wallet as our final piece. We will research, design and evaluate a range of products as well as learn to join fabric with two different stitch types.

French
In French we will be learning basic body parts such as head, eyes, nose, arms and legs. We will be designing imaginary characters and explaining their features using our new vocabulary.

Computing
In Computing, we will create animations using drawings, backgrounds and characters.

PE (Team Theme)
This term PE lessons will focus on the sport of cricket. We will learn how to play Kwik cricket and then finish the term with two weeks of rounders.

Music
Children will continue to develop their recorder playing this term, increasing the difficulty of the pieces they are performing.

PSHE
PSHE this term is all about 'Changing me'. We will discuss how our bodies change when we get older. We will discuss 'unique me', 'puberty and menstruation', 'being part of a family' and understanding that some changes we can control and some we cannot.
