Writing

In English, we will be drawing inspiration from *The Iron Man* by Ted Hughes. This term, our main focuses include using time adverbials, exploring a range of sentence structures and proofreading and editing our work to make improvements..



Reading

Throughout the term, we will focus on making predictions and using evidence from the text to justify our thinking. We will also continue to foster a love of reading by encouraging children to explore a range of genres, including non-fiction, during Reading for Pleasure sessions and library visits.



Term 6

Learning Journey

DT – In DT, we will be exploring food and nutrition, learning about healthy ingredients and balanced diets. We will then design and make our own Viking bread and pesto.

History – As part of our whole-school theme of Victory and Defeat, we will be learning about the Vikings.

PE – In PE, we will be developing our striking and fielding skills through cricket and rounders.

Music – In Music, we will be developing our singing techniques through a range of Viking-themed songs and performances.

RE – In RE, we will be exploring the lives of Christians in Britain.

Maths

In Maths this term, we will continue to develop our fluency in the 3, 4 and 8 times tables. We will be learning about money, including converting between pounds and pence and adding and subtracting amounts. We will also explore time, developing our ability to read analogue and digital clocks, calculate durations and solve a range of real-life problems involving time.



Science

In Science this term, we will be learning about skeletons, exploring the names and functions of different bones and how our skeleton supports, protects and helps our bodies to move. We will also investigate sustainability, considering the impact of food waste and how we can make more responsible choices
