Writing

Following our new text 'The Emperor's Egg' the children will be writing a setting description and an information leaflet. Within their writing, they will be including adjectives to describe and using the correct plural forms, as well as reinforcing our non-negotiable full stops, capital letters and finger spaces. We shall focus on it is important that the children begin to read over their own work in order to identify, correct and develop their ideas.

Reading

As well as our reading book for English, year 1 will be taking home two books each week; one of them being a book of choice from our school library, and the other a 'ditty' book to support our phonics. Throughout the week, the children participate in 'Whole Class Reading', where they study and discuss a text over the course of a few days. The text choices will be linked to the 'Victory and Defeat' theme for the term.

Maths

This term, year 1 will learn place value within 100. They shall learn to recognise coins and notes and count coins, as well as focusing on time. Pelicans will learn the days of the week, months of the year as well as hours, minutes and seconds, alongside telling the time to the hour and half hour.
