



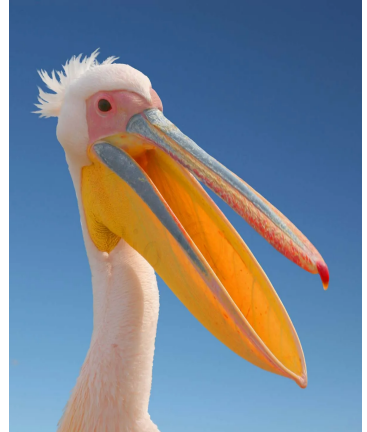

In art, our focus is drawing a texture with our main medium being chalk.

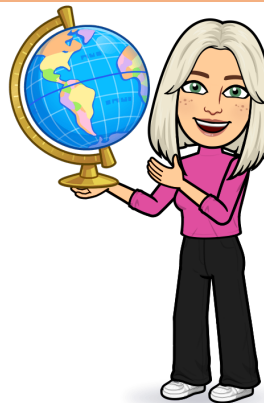
Phonics & Reading

The children will be sent home with 3 reading books this term. A ditty book (a levelled book which follows on from the reading they have been doing in class each week), an individual levelled book and a library book of their choosing. Some children may also bring home an AR book.

Please read with your child at least 3 times a week. We have implemented individual reward charts, where the children will win prizes for reading a certain amount of times at home. The more they read, the better the prizes. Please ensure you are writing in their purple reading record every time you read at home.
