Science

In science this term we will be learning about animals. We will be learning to recognise, identify and name a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals. We will be looking at grouping animals and will be able to identify common characteristics of each animal group. We will also be exploring the growth of plants throughout the next couple of terms.

English - Reading

Our text this term is called, "How to Find Gold". To compliment this, we will be reading other adventure stories. These should be inspiring and encourage the children to be imaginative. We will also be reading a variety of non-fiction texts and poetry throughout the term. We will continue to practise our phonics daily in our whole class sessions, as well as our daily reading sessions where each group will have a reading for pleasure session to further encourage a love of reading.

English - Writing

We will be writing a variety of different texts this term, including an explanation text, an acrostic poem and a book report. We will be learning to use question marks and explanations as well as using the suffix -ed.
