This terms topic for the school is 'Land and Water'. In year 2 we will be undertaking a coastal project looking carefully at the key features of coasts and answering the questions;

What is a coastal area? How do our actions impact the coast? What are the changes over time to a coastal area? After our visit to Folkestone, where we explored the harbour, the sandy beach, the pebbly beach and looked at the features we can see in a coastal area, we will use this to help with our Geography learning.

This year, the Government have decided that the year 2 cohorts across the country do not have to be assessed through statutory testing. It has been suggested that the children in this year group still need a method of assessment, so throughout the month of May, children in Parrots class will be taking some assessment papers (which are very similar to the papers they have seen over the past year).

These will be conducted in small groups with a familiar adult.
