## Maths

**Fractions** – making equal parts, finding a half, finding a quarter, recognising and finding a third. Counting in fractions. Finding  $\frac{3}{4}$ . Understanding the equivalence of  $\frac{1}{2}$  and  $\frac{2}{4}$

**Position and Direction** – use mathematical vocabulary to describe position, direction and movement. Understand turns and refer to these in terms of fractions, e.g. a half turn or quarter turn. Order and arrange mathematical pictures in sequences.

**Time**– tell and write the time to 15-minute intervals, be able to draw these times on a clock. Know how many minutes in an hour and how many hours in a day. Compare and sequence intervals of time.
