English Reading

English Writing

The children will focus on creating a diary
account, developing their skills to use a
subordinate clause and conjunctions to show
time, place and cause.

They will move on to retell the story and
include prepositions to show time, place and
cause.

Science

The children will
investigate rocks,
evaluating their
attributes in order to
group them. They will
look at the composition
of soil, how fossils form
and recognise the
organisms within them.

Maths

Multiplication and division - This will involve multiplying
and dividing a two digit number by a one digit number, so
there is exchanging and partitioning.

Length and perimeter – This term we shall be learning to
measure in mm, cm and metres and their equivalent
measures. We shall add, subtract and compare lengths and
use our knowledge to measure and calculate perimeter.

zones (including day and night).
