Ravens will be continue to learn basic phrases in French, both spoken and in written forms.



The school theme for this term is

Year 4 will be begin by recapping their Geography learning from previous years, such as identifying basic compass points and describing features within an environment as either human or physical. They will build on this knowledge and extend their ability to describe direction by using the 8 point compass and learning about what these points are called. Ravens will also have the opportunity to study a range of Ordnance Survey maps, identifying map symbols and locating information by using 4-figure grid

references. Finally, we will use a range of sources to explore land use in and around the Ashford area., comparing similarities and differences and suggesting reasons for the uses that we find.

Ravens will have PE on Fridays. Please remember to send your child into school in their PE kit. Please remove earrings as we are not allowed to tape over them or remove them.

Home Learning & Reading

Home learning will continue to be set on Thursday via Family Announcements on Seesaw. Written tasks should continue to be recorded in their orange homework books and all homework needs to be completed and returned to school by Tuesday of the following week so that it can be marked by an adult.

'MAPS'

Children will continue to can bring their AR books home each night to read. These must be brought into school daily so the children can quiz on the book they have read and change it on a set day. We only have 2 allocated AR sessions a week in class so children need to be supporting this by reading at home in order to be on track to meet their points targets.

Spellings will continue to be set on Spelling Shed and children have access to the Year 1 and 2, as well as Year 3 and 4 common exception words through this platform.

We have set up a display in our classroom to track children's involvement with Doodle Tables. All children should now have mastered their 2,5 and 10x tables on Doodle Tables, if not, please practice these over half term. We would then ask that you work on your 3,4.9 and 11x tables—these are the facts needed for the next maths badge!
