Welcome back; I hope you have all enjoyed your summer break and are looking forward to a new school year.

Behaviour policy changes:

I am sure that your children have already begun to mention the new behaviour rules at Phoenix so I thought I would take a few moments to let you know about the key changes.

Our behaviour policy itself will be shared with parents and carers once it has been ratified by governors but in the meantime, here are the key differences for you to know:

- 1) There is a heavy emphasis on rewards, we have lots more rewards for the children who show good behaviour and hopefully you will start to see the children getting excited about their new badges and the tickets they are earning to spend in our school shop.
- 2) We no longer have Red and Yellow cards. These have changed and we now call sanctions Consequences. These are levelled as C1, C2 and C3. C1 are minor consequences dealt with in class; C2 are consequences where the child is continuing to behave inappropriately and this will be reported to parents/carers by the teacher if they happen; and C3 is the most severe consequence which will result in time out of class and the Senior Leadership Team (The Headteacher, Deputy or SENCO usually) ringing home to discuss with parents/carers. As a continuation of our zero tolerance to fighting any fighting will automatically result in a C3.

We will of course put the new policy on the website as soon as we are able and we will let parents know when it is available.

We would suggest that you and your child go and look around all the schools that you are interested in. Dates have been sent to you separately.

- **Year 5 Swimming –** Swimming starts next week Tuesday 16th September; don't forget to send your child in with their things.
- Weekly Mile every Tuesday morning the children will take part in our 'weekly mile run' around the school grounds. Children can walk or run for the allocated time. Please ensure your child comes to school in their trainers every Tuesday.
- **Uniform** Please only send your child to school in a plain white polo t-shirt and plain black or grey trousers/shorts/skirts or the girls can wear a blue and white checked dress. What the children wear makes a huge difference to their ability to concentrate and thus their learning.

- **Breakfast club** You will need to book pre-book and pay for a space before your child can attend.

Illness

If your child is ill and unable to come to school please ensure you call the office and leave a message (24-hour answer machine available). If they have a bug (sickness or diarrhoea) which they could pass on to another child they will need to stay at home for 48 hours; if they are sick for any other reason (i.e. headache) they should return to school as soon as they feel well enough.

Holiday requests/penalty notices

PENALTY

All holiday leave requests will need to be made in writing to the Headteacher. Following KCC guidance and the School's Attendance Policy leave will only be authorised in exceptional circumstances. Any child whose attendance for the past 12 months is below 95% will be monitored regularly and letters will be sent home. Having 6 days a year off will take your child's attendance below 95%. This will have a negative effect on their learning.

School trips

At Phoenix we like to give the children as many varied learning opportunities as possible and this includes class trips which are only possible because we are lucky enough to have our minibus. Obviously, school trips involve extra costs which puts a strain on the school budget but by having our minibus does mean the cost of all trips at kept at a minimum. However, to allow trips to take place we do have to ask parents/carers for a voluntary contribution towards these events. We understand that times are hard but unfortunately without these contributions we will not be able to provide class trips. Contributions can be paid via Parent mail or by cash at the office and can be made in instalments. If you need a longer period to fulfil the contributions please speak to a member of staff who will arrange this for you. Thank you for your continued support.
