- **No jewellery** – in the interest of safety please ensure that NO child comes to school wearing any type of necklace, bracket or hooped ear-rings.
- **PE kits** – Please ensure that your child comes to school in the correct PE uniform on their PE day. This makes a huge difference to their learning, behaviour and their ability to concentrate. Children need to wear plain black or blue joggers/shorts, their house colour PE top with black trainers.
- **Breakfast club** – in order to ensure the correct supervision of the children in breakfast club it is vital that you pre-book and pay for a space for your child. Children and siblings who attend morning boosters will not have to pay or pre-book a space. As boosters have now started spaces are limited so please book early.
- **Flu vaccinations** – NHS will be visiting school on 3<sup>rd</sup> November to carry out the flu vaccinations. Please ensure you complete the online form via <http://www.kentcht.nhs.uk/imms> before midnight on 30.10.23 to state Yes or No.
- **Secondary school applications for Year 6** – If your child is in Year 6 you will need to apply online for a Year 7 space for them at your chosen secondary school. ### **Illness**

If your child is ill and unable to come to school please ensure you call the office and leave a message (24-hour answer machine available). If they have a bug (sickness or diarrhoea) which they could pass on to another child they will need to stay at home for 48 hours; if they are sick for any other reason (i.e. headache) they should return to school as soon as they feel well enough.

### **Holiday requests/penalty notices**



All holiday leave requests will need to be made in writing to the Headteacher. Following KCC guidance and the School's Attendance Policy leave will only be authorised in exceptional circumstances. Any child whose attendance for the past 12 months is below 95% will be monitored regularly and letters will be sent home. Having 6 days a year off will take your child's attendance below 95%. This will have a negative effect on their learning.

### **School trips**

At Phoenix we like to give the children as many varied learning opportunities as possible and this includes class trips which are only possible because we are lucky enough to have our minibus. Obviously, school trips involve extra costs which puts a strain on the school budget but by having our minibus does mean the cost of all trips at kept at a minimum. However, to allow trips to take place we do have to ask parents/carers for a voluntary contribution towards these events. We understand that times are hard but unfortunately without these contributions we will not be able to provide class trips. Contributions can be paid via Parent mail or by cash at the office and can be made in instalments. If you need a longer period to fulfil the contributions please speak to a member of staff who will arrange this for you. Thank you for your continued support.

### **PE Kits**

Please ensure that your child comes to school in their PE on their allocated day. **Children need to wear their house PE top, school sweatshirt and plain black joggers/shorts. Earrings must be removed for health and safety purposes. This should happen at home. Our staff are unable to remove or replace earrings.**

Gates are open between 8.40am and 8.50am. Any child arriving at school after this time will need to enter through the main office. Any child arriving after 9.00am will be recorded as 'unauthorised'.
